Dear blessed Muslims,

I remind myself and fellow audience to strengthen our *taqwa* of Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* with absolute *taqwa* by fulfilling all of His Commands and avoiding all of His prohibitions. May we attain blissfulness in this world and the Hereafter.

Today, I will be discussing upon a *khutbah* titled "**CHARITY BRINGS BLESSINGS.**"

Giving charity is an act that is highly encouraged in Islam. It is because giving charity is a manifestation of our gratitude to Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* and as a way of strengthening the relationship between the slaves and Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*, and also amongst slaves, as mentioned in verse 254 of soorah al-Baqarah:

"O you who have believed, spend from that which We have provided for you before there comes a Day in which there is no exchange and no friendship and no intercession. And the disbelievers - they are the wrongdoers."

Dear beloved Muslims,

A Muslim that gives charity is a true manifestation of his honesty in his religiosity. That is why Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم mentioned *sadaqah* (charity) as "*burhaan*" (proof), as mentioned in the *hadeeth* of Abu Maalik al-Haarith bin 'Aasim al-Ash'ari *radhiyAllaahu 'anh*, where Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم said:

الطُّهُورُ شَطْرُ الْإِيمَانِ، وَالْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ تَمْلَأُ الْمِيزَانَ، وَسُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَالْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ تَمْلَأُنِ أَوْ تَمْلَأُ مَا بَيْنَ السَّمَاءِ وَالْأَرْضِ، وَالصَّلَاةُ نُورٌ، وَالصَّدَقَةُ بُرْهَانٌ

"Purity is half of imaan. 'Alhamdulillah' fills the scales, and 'SubhaanAllaah' and 'Alhamdulillah' fill that which is between heaven and earth. And the salaah is a light, and charity is a proof."

(Muslim)

Giving charity is inseparable from our good deeds, whether it is intended for the poor, needy, relatives, or in the path of Allah. Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* mentions in verse 215 of soorah al-Baqarah:

يَسْأَلُونَكَ مَاذَا يُنْفِقُونَ قُلْ مَا أَنْفَقْتُمْ مِنْ خَيْرٍ فَلِلْوَالِدَيْنِ وَالْأَقْرَبِينَ وَالْيَتَامَىٰ
وَالْمَسْكِينِ وَابْنِ السَّبِيلِ وَمَا تَفْعَلُوا مِنْ خَيْرٍ فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ بِهِ عَلِيمٌ ﴿٢١٥﴾

"They ask you, [O Muhammad], what they should spend. Say, "Whatever you spend of good is [to be] for parents and relatives and orphans and the needy and the traveler. And whatever you do of good - indeed, Allah is Knowing of it.""

Dear beloved Muslims,

Verily, giving *sadaqah* must be done purely with *ikhlaas* (sincerity) for the sake of Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*, not to gain fame and reward. We are not allowed to harp others about our deeds, so what more in showing off, complain, and hurting the feelings of those on the receiving end. Aside from that, Islam teaches its adherents to ensure the items that are being given in charity to be in good and usable condition, originating from *halaal* (permissible) sources. Even better, they are to be from items that are well liked and even loved by its owner.

Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* mentions in verse 92 of soorah Aal-'Imraan:

لَنْ تَنَالُوا الْبِرَّ حَتَّىٰ تُنْفِقُوا مِمَّا تُحِبُّونَ ۚ وَمَا تُنْفِقُوا مِنْ شَيْءٍ فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ بِهِ
عَلِيمٌ ﴿٩٢﴾

"Never will you attain the good [reward] until you spend [in the way of Allah] from that which you love. And whatever you spend - indeed, Allah is Knowing of it."

Blessed audience,

Indeed, *sadaqah* that are made in secret is more preferred, so much so that the left hand does not know what the right hand has given. It can also expiate the misdeeds and sins of those giving *sadaqah*. This righteous deed can take one closer to sincerity and keep one away from arrogance, for arrogance will destroy the charitable deeds performed. Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* mentions in verse 271 of soorah al-Baqarah:

إِنْ تُبْدُوا الصَّدَقَاتِ فَنِعِمَّا هِيَ ۚ وَإِنْ تُخْفُوهَا وَتُؤْتُوهَا الْفُقَرَاءَ فَهُوَ خَيْرٌ لَكُمْ
وَيُكَفِّرُ عَنْكُمْ مِنْ سَيِّئَاتِكُمْ ۗ وَاللَّهُ بِمَا تَعْمَلُونَ خَبِيرٌ ﴿٢٧١﴾



"If you disclose your charitable expenditures, they are good; but if you conceal them and give them to the poor, it is better for you, and He will remove from you some of your misdeeds [thereby]. And Allah, with what you do, is [fully] Acquainted."

Blessed Muslims,

Indeed, charity does not decrease one's wealth. Instead, it increases one's wealth and keeps one away from poverty, deficiency, and hardship in life.

Rasulullah ﷺ had given guarantee that *sadaqah* will not at all decrease one's wealth. Narrated Abu Hurayrah *radhiyAllaahu 'anh* that Rasulullah ﷺ said:

مَا نَقَصَتْ صَدَقَةٌ مِنْ مَالٍ

"Charity does not in any way decrease the wealth."

(Muslim)

Whatever wealth spent will be multiplied and definitely replaced. In the *hadeeth* of Abu Hurayrah *radhiyAllaahu 'anh*, Rasulullah ﷺ said:

مَا مِنْ يَوْمٍ يُصْبِحُ الْعِبَادُ فِيهِ، إِلَّا مَلَكَانِ يَنْزِلَانِ، فَيَقُولُ أَحَدُهُمَا: اللَّهُمَّ
أَعْطِ مُنْفِقًا خَلْفًا، وَيَقُولُ الْآخَرُ: اللَّهُمَّ أَعْطِ مُمْسِكًا تَلَفًا

"There is never a day wherein servants (of God) get up at morn, but are not visited by two angels. One of them says: "O Allah, give him more who spends (for the sake of Allah)," and the other says: "O Allah, bring destruction to one who withholds.""

(al-Bukhaari and Muslim)

Dearest audience,

To end the *khutbah* today, I would like to invite fellow audience to ponder upon the following matters:

1. The Muslim *ummah* must have certainty that giving charity is a command from Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* that is promised with tremendous reward as proof of one's *imaan* (faith) unto Him.
2. The Muslim *ummah* must increase in charity and spending in the path of Allah with utmost sincerity.
3. The Muslim *ummah* must avoid miserliness and stinginess, as well as not harp others about the *sadaqah* made.



4. The Muslim *ummah* must inculcate giving charity as a norm, before death overtakes in all of a sudden.

Dear blessed audience,

Once again, I would like to remind all of us to always have the *taqwa* of Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* and realize that Islam teaches us to remain moderate in every actions and deeds. As Muslims, we are to manifest noble *akhlaaq*, having utmost personality and attitude for Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم was sent to perfect *akhlaaq* and as mercy for the entire mankind and the worlds. Therefore, let us always increase our *salawaat* and *salaam* upon our Prophet Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم. Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* mentions:

"Indeed, Allah confers blessing upon the Prophet, and His angels [ask Him to do so]. O you who have believed, ask [Allah to confer] blessing upon him and ask [Allah to grant him] peace."

(al-Ahzaab 33:56)
