Dear blessed Muslims,

I would like to earnestly remind dear respected audience to altogether strive to increase our *taqwa* of Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Taʻaala* by performing all of His Commands, as well as avoiding all of His prohibitions. May Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Taʻaala* bless our lives with *niʻmah* (favors), *tawfeeq* (aid) and *hidaayah* (guidance) that are long-lasting, that we attain success in this world and the Hereafter.

In conjunction with this noble day, I invite fellow congregation to ponder upon a khutbah titled "SHARING OUR SUSTENANCE."

Dear blessed audience,

It is common in the human lives to become afflicted with various trials and challenges that are to be endured with patience and determination.

Each and every one of us will be faced with life challenges that vary from one another. That is why we must always aid one another, helping each other, and providing motivation and encouragement when seeing our companions afflicted with calamities or difficulties.

The 'ibaadah (act of worship) of zakaah is the solution that was legislated by Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala for us, intending for all bounties and provisions to be shared together with those that are being tested with sufferings and calamities.

Through this 'ibaadah of zakaah, it proves that Islam strongly emphasize on the traits of love and compassion amongst fellow human beings, while rejecting arrogance and selfishness. Its juristic ruling being waajib (obligatory) upon the Muslim ummah clearly manifests Islam as a religion that commands us to have mahabbah (love) and affection.

Fulfilling *zakaat* is a guidance that was bestowed by Allah in solving the issue of poverty. We must truly comprehend that within the wealth that we possess, there are rights that truly belong to others that must be separated through *zakaat*. If every Muslim fully understands and internalize upon this matter, then the rights of the poor and needy

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will be upheld. Moreover, wealth ownership will not just circulate amongst the rich only. Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* mentions in verse 7 of soorah al-Hashr:

"And what Allah restored to His Messenger from the people of the towns - it is for Allah and for the Messenger and for [his] near relatives and orphans and the [stranded] traveler - so that it will not be a perpetual distribution among the rich from among you. And whatever the Messenger has given you - take; and what he has forbidden you - refrain from. And fear Allah; indeed, Allah is severe in penalty."

Respected audience,

If we are to scrutinize further, the amount that Allah had decreed upon us for *zakaat* is very small. Only 2.5% is obligated to be forked out for *zakaat* from our earnings, gold, silver, savings, and commerce, after fulfilling the required *nisaab* (amount) and *hawl* (duration). Hence, those claiming that fulfilling *zakaat* is troublesome and burdensome, in reality they have been truly deceived by their evil desire and *Shaytaan*.

If we perform *zakaat* with sincerity purely hoping for the pleasure of Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala*, then have certainty (*yaqeen*) that Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* will bestow upon us happiness, success, and blessings in this life and the Hereafter. On the contrary, if *zakaat* that is due is not fulfilled, then take heed of the severe torment from Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* that awaits in the Hereafter. Allah *Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala* mentions in verses 34-35 of soorah at-Tawbah:

"...And those who hoard gold and silver and spend it not in the way of Allah - give them tidings of a painful punishment. The Day when it will be heated in the fire of Hell and seared therewith will be their foreheads, their flanks, and their backs, [it will be said], "This is what you hoarded for yourselves, so taste what you used to hoard.""

Dear blessed audience,

The Lembaga Zakat Selangor (LZS; Selangor Zakaat Board) is an organization appointed by His Royal Highness the Sultan of Selangor, to administer the affairs of



zakaat in this state. LZS is thoroughly audited by five (5) independent auditors from various agencies including the National Audit Department; in ensuring that zakaat collection and disbursement are implemented transparently. Furthermore, the audit report is disclosed to the public in the Annual Report, just like the National Audit report.

Based on the *zakaat* distribution report in Selangor for 2016, a total of **RM697.5 million** was disbursed to the **eight (8)** categories of *asnaf* (*zakaat* recipients) in the state of Selangor. The disbursed amount had increased due to the improved service quality by LZS in executing *zakaat* distribution efforts according to priorities and needs based on *al-Maqaasid ash-Sharee'ah* (the Higher Objectives of the *Sharee'ah*).

Therefore, as we are approaching the end of the year 2017, which will soon dawn upon us, I would like to firmly remind the audience to fulfill the obligation of zakaah through the Selangor Zakaat Board, in ensuring that the favors of rizq (sustenance) that Allah Subhaanahu Wa Ta'aala had bestowed upon us are shared with those in need and impoverished.

Let us ensure that our accumulated wealth that is based upon the *nisaab* of gold such as our savings and gold, which includes our earnings, commerce, entrepreneurship, EPF withdrawals, and others have been "purified" through *zakaat*.

Therefore, the Selangor *Zakaat* Board provides various facilities for the Muslims to fulfill their *zakaat* obligation through 28 *zakaat* counters available, in addition to Internet banking and others.

Dear blessed Muslims,

To end the *khutbah* on a day that is full of *barakah* (blessings), let us take lessons as in the following:

- 1. It is *waajib* upon the Muslim *ummah* to have certainty that fulfilling *zakaah* is one of the pillars of Islam that is compulsory. The refusal to fulfill this pillar will only incur the wrath of Allah on the Day of Judgment.
- 2. The Muslim *ummah* must share its *rizq* by fulfilling *zakaah*, which brings divine mercy, and further solidifies *silaaturrahm* (ties of kinship) amongst mankind.
- 3. Let us hasten to fulfill our *zakaat*, in bringing joy to the recipients especially the *fuqaraa*' (poor) and *masaakeen* (needy), as they wade through their lives that are ever increasingly challenging.
- 4. The Muslim *ummah* shall fulfill their *zakaat* through the Selangor *Zakaat* Board, in ensuring that its disbursement will benefit even more eligible recipients.
